High Adventure Trip

- The Committee has mentioned the discussed the possibility of a high adventure trip for quite some time now.
- Planning for a 2020/2021 trip should begin soon. We need to appoint a chairperson for this project.
 - Agreed we are too late for 2020 at this point
- We need parent / scout commitment as there will be a non-refundable deposit if we make a reservation.
- Should someone (Frank?) present on Philmont and / or Seabase at the next court of honor to explain to parents the types of trips and what is involved?
 - Rob will send out a parents note asking about interest given we do have a correct email list.
- Seabase (https://www.bsaseabase.org/)
 - Seabase
 - Mostly 6 night / 7 day trips
 - Max Crew size is about 6-8 including adults for most adventures (2 adults required)
 - Max ratio allowed is 50/50
 - Must be able to complete BSA Swim Test (No beginner / non-swimmers)
 - Cost range from \$7,600 to \$18,500 per crew depending on which adventure is selected
 - Choices
